Cedar-Knox PPD offers a loan program to our customers called REDL&G. We were designated recipients of those funds from the USDA in 2007. For more than 15 years we have helped several small businesses to provide economic development. These funds shape and strengthen our rural infrastructure, spur rural economy and increase per capital income with low interest loans.

Types of Loans:

> Partnership Loans

 Provide "gap" financing to entrepreneurs unable to access 100% of the needed financing from a financial institution.

> Microloans

• Loans under \$50,000 that can be finalized without bank participation.

Eligibility:

- At least one full time equivalent job must be created or retained for each \$35,000 in loan dollars.
- Loan dollars may not represent more than 40% of the total financing needs

• 10%-20% equity is generally required.

FOR YOUR BUSINESS

 Bank financing is encouraged and preferred with each borrower, but not required.

- To promote and assist the growth and development of business and industrial concerns with Northeast and North Central Nebraska.



LIGHTNING ARRESTER

Many of us have heard about the importance of having a surge arrester for our homes. A surge arrester is a device that protects your electrical equipment from damage caused by overvoltage. A typical surge arrester has both a ground terminal and a high-voltage terminal. When a powerful electric surge travels from the power system to the surge arrester, the high voltage current is sent directly to the ground to avoid damaging the equipment in your home. In a similar way, Cedar-Knox uses a different version called lightning arrestors on our electric grid. We also realize the importance of protecting the system from overvoltage situations, so these are installed throughout the district to protect from...you guessed it, lightning. The



lightning arrester takes the surge to the ground, therefore protecting the system. The lightning arrestor is mounted near critical infrastructure equipment to not only protect the apparatus but also the load or service that is feeds.
