19[™] SUBSTATION ENERGIZED

On June 5th, CKPPD energized the district's 19th substation, which is located near Pleasant Valley. The addition of this 5,000 KVA substation will be used to relieve some loading on other nearby substations and allow capacity for future load growth in the area. Two of the four distribution circuits are currently online with the other two expected to be energized later this summer when distribution line builds are complete.


